he Federal Government has named Dr Mohammed Lawan Yahuza as the Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of the Governing Council of Federal University Oye Ekiti, (FOUYE).

Please note that accreditation for each of the group commences an hour earlier to the scheduled time for the examination.


